Overview: Use pictures to tell the important parts of the story

Details:

- The report must include 8-10 main plot points. Remember our study of summaries. You need to pick the 8-10 **most important** moments of the book. Each page will represent 1 important part. You are retelling the story through images.
- Pictures may be hand drawn, cut from magazines, newspapers, etc., colored, or printed. You may choose one method of pictures or may mix them throughout the report.
- After you have created the scenes, add 2-3 sentences to each page describing what it is and why it's important to the story.
- Make a nice cover for your project, which includes a title and your name.
- Finally, bind your book in any simple and creative manner you choose. (hole punch and tie with twine, ribbon, etc. , place in a small binder or folder, nicely staple, etc.)
