DRESS CODE:

REGISTRATION

A **\$60.00 non-refundable registration (which includes a summer t-shirt and backpack)** is required to officially register each child that will be attending the summer program. This requirement assures us of your commitment to the summer program and assists us in planning for special activities, buses, and staffing. Limited space is available once adequate staffing is planned according to the registration response. For this reason, it is important that you return your registration form and \$60.00 registration fee by **Friday, May 17th**.

T-SHIRTS

A "**Camp Whereiwannabe 2019**" t-shirt is required to be worn for all field trips. T-shirts from previous years will NOT be allowed for field trip days. If your child does not have the 2019 camp t-shirt on field trip days, your account will be billed \$10.00 for a replacement shirt.

TUITION

\$150.00 per week. There is **no discount** rate for additional children. Prices include service hours, all field trips, and planned activities. **No hourly or daily rates.** Payment is due Monday by 6pm a \$15.00 late fee will be applied after that.

If your child remains on campus after 6 p.m., overtime charges will apply. (\$15.00 from 6:00-6:05, additional \$1.00 per minute after 6:05)

FIELD TRIPS

Field Trips will be scheduled every week. Admission is included in the weekly fee; however, snack and lunch fees needed for field trips will vary with the activity. **PLEASE CHECK THE INFORMATION BOARD INSIDE THE DAYCARE ROOM DAILY FOR IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS.**

1. I will promptly pay \$150.00 per week as well as all fees and charges as established. A fee of \$35.00 will be charged in the case of a returned check. Furthermore, I agree to pay all costs incurred by the school for collection of fees should such actions become necessary.
