Please review these guidelines for school supplies needed by each student on the first day of school. Take advantage of store sales, but don't let promotional gimmicks take advantage of you, by encouraging you to buy "data files" or other unnecessary items for your elementary student. These are often more of a distraction than a tool. *Remember*, it's hard to improve on the basic tools. Stick to the basics.

Below is a list of supplies that your Junior High student will need for the 2022/2023 school year:

- 1 1/2-inch binder
- Binder pocket dividers (5 pack)
- College ruled notebook paper, (500-600 sheets)
Replenish as needed
- (2) College ruled spiral notebooks
- Soft-sided pencil pouch for inside your binder
(**No hard-sided pencil boxes please**)
- (1 ea.) Blue, black, and red ink pens
- Multicolor ink pens for notetaking (**8th grade only**)
- (2) Highlighters
- (1 pair) Scissors
- (500) Notecards 3"x5" – replenish as needed
- (2) Glue sticks - replenish as needed
- Mechanical pencils and lead (0.7 = a #2 pencil) or
2 boxes of #2 wooden pencils (**Please do not get decorated pencils as they have a plastic coating that harms the pencil sharpener.**)
- (5) Composition books
- (3) Reams of white copy paper**
- (1) Box tissue
- (3) Large containers Clorox Wipes
- (1) Roll paper towels
- 12-pack colored pencils
- 12-pack markers (**No sharpies please**)
- Hand sanitizer (12-16 oz)
- Plastic Storage Crate
(17 1/4" X 14 1/4" X 10 5/8")
- Bible for all returning students
